

DECLARATION OF DISASTER
In the City of Rosenberg


WHEREAS, the City of Rosenberg, Fort Bend County, Texas on the 29th day of May, 2015, is threatened with widespread or severe damage, injury, or loss of life or property, due to the threat of disaster from projected flood hazard areas; and,

WHEREAS, the Mayor of Rosenberg has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to put a plan in place to alleviate the suffering of people and to protect property in case the City of Rosenberg has flooded areas.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE MAYOR OF ROSENBERG:

1. That a local state of disaster is hereby declared for the City of Rosenberg pursuant to Section 418.108(a) of the Texas Government Code.
2. Pursuant to Section 418.018(b) of the Government Code, the state of disaster shall continue for a period of not more than seven days from the date of this declaration unless continued or renewed by the City Council of Rosenberg.
3. Pursuant to Section 418.018(c) of the Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the City Secretary.
4. Pursuant to Section 418.018(d) of the Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster activates the City Emergency Operations Plan and that this proclamation shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance.
