

**EVACUATION ORDER**  
In the City of Rosenberg

Due to flooding and the potential for flooding, Fort Bend County has issued a recommended evacuation order for residents and visitors in areas north of Avenue A from 1<sup>st</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> Street, and areas along 6<sup>th</sup> Street from Avenue B to Avenue D, Rosenberg, Texas, effective 9:00 p.m., May 29, 2015. After 9:00 p.m., Friday, May 29, 2015, no access will be allowed to the area as referenced above.


All residents and visitors in areas north of Avenue A from 1<sup>st</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> Street, and areas along 6<sup>th</sup> Street from Avenue B to Avenue D, Rosenberg, Texas, are advised to evacuate as expediently as possible before the effects of Brazos River flooding begin to bring high, rapidly moving, water to the area as referenced above.

A Declaration of Disaster has been issued for the City of Rosenberg.

It is imperative that you follow the directions of local law enforcement.

Those evacuating from areas north of Avenue A from 1<sup>st</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> Street, and areas along 6<sup>th</sup> Street from Avenue B to Avenue D, Rosenberg, Texas. Evacuating as recommended will help avoid traffic backups and congestion that may prolong evacuation and will help to ensure your safety in the face of rising flood waters.
