

**TERMINATION OF EVACUATION ORDER  
In the City of Rosenberg**

**AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE TERMINATION OF THE  
MANDATORY EVACUATION ORDER REGARDING FLOODED AREAS IN  
THE CITY OF ROSENBERG.**

**WHEREAS**, on the 29th day of May, 2015, the Mayor, pursuant to the Texas Government Code, Chapter 418, of the "Texas Disaster Act", issued an Evacuation Order declaring a local state of disaster for the City of Rosenberg, Fort Bend County, Texas resulting from:

The imminent flooding of the Brazos River for the residents and visitors in areas north of Avenue A from 1<sup>st</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> Streets, and areas along 6<sup>th</sup> Street from Avenue B to Avenue D, Rosenberg, Texas;

**WHEREAS**, the conditions necessitating the Evacuation Order of a local state of disaster have ceased to exist; and

**WHEREAS**, the Texas Disaster Act provides that a local state of disaster may be terminated by the governing body of the political subdivision or by executive order of the Mayor.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF ROSENBERG:**

Section 1. That the Mayor, as the governing body of the City of Rosenberg, by verbal order, terminated the Evacuation Order at 5:00 p.m. on Sunday, May 31, 2015, as described in the preamble above.
