### FORT BEND COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 155


The Board of Directors of Fort Bend County Municipal Utility District No. 155 will hold a regular meeting on **Monday, November 10, 2014, at 11:00 a.m.** at Bonbrook Plantation Recreational Center, 9210 Reading Road, Rosenberg, Texas, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following items:


1. Approve minutes.
2. Security services.
3. Financial and bookkeeping matters, including payment of the bills, review of investments.
4. Operation of District water, sanitary sewer, and drainage facilities, billings and repairs and maintenance.
5. Hearing on termination of water and sewer service to delinquent customers and authorize termination of service.
6. Update on detention/amenity lakes maintenance, including:
  - a. Trees of Houston donation, including planting and maintenance; and
  - b. Review proposals for detention/amenity lake maintenance providers and authorize appropriate action and terminate Greenscape Associates service agreement, if appropriate.
7. Tax assessment and collections matters, including delinquent tax collections, installment agreements, and payment of tax bills.
8. Engineering matters, including:
  - a. authorize design of facilities in the service area;
  - b. approve plans and specifications and authorize advertisement for bids for construction of projects in the service area, including:
    - i. Bonbrook Plantation North, Section 14.
  - c. review bids and award contract for construction;
  - d. approve pay estimates and change orders for construction of:
    - i. Bonbrook Plantation North, Section 10;
    - ii. water, sewer, and drainage facilities to serve Bonbrook Plantation North, Section 13;
    - iii. water, sewer, and drainage facilities to serve Bonbrook Plantation North, Sections 11 and 12;
    - iv. Detention Pond D; and
    - v. water, sewer, and drainage facilities to serve Bonbrook Plantation South, Section 5 and Reading Road Extension.
  - e. deeds, easements, consents to encroachment, requests for service or utility commitment letters;
  - f. update on application for approval to use surplus funds to reimburse the developers for the wastewater plant expansion; and
