



NOTICE OF MEETING

FORT BEND COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 155

The Board of Directors of Fort Bend County Municipal Utility District No. 155 will hold a regular meeting on **Monday, May 11, 2015, at 11:00 a.m.** at Bonbrook Plantation Recreational Center, 9210 Reading Road, Rosenberg, Texas, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following items:

1. Approve minutes.
2. Public comments.
3. Security services.
4. Travel Reimbursement Guidelines and Director Expenses for the Association of Water Board Directors summer conference.
5. Financial and bookkeeping matters, including payment of the bills, review of investments.
6. Operation of District water, sanitary sewer, and drainage facilities, billings and repairs and maintenance, including:
 - a. review Critical Load Spreadsheet for District's facilities and authorize annual filing; and
 - b. Approve Consumer Confidence Report and authorize operator to mail Consumer Confidence Report and file certificate of mailing with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality.
7. Hearing on termination of water and sewer service to delinquent customers and authorize termination of service.
8. Garbage and recycling matters.
9. Update on detention/amenity lakes maintenance.
10. Tax assessment and collections matters, including delinquent tax collections, installment agreements, and payment of tax bills.
11. Engineering matters, including:
 - a. authorize design of facilities in the service area;
 - b. approve plans and specifications and authorize advertisement for bids for construction of projects in the service area;
 - c. review bids and award contract for construction;
 - d. approve pay estimates and change orders for construction of:
 - i. Bonbrook Plantation North, Section 14.
 - e. deeds, easements, consents to encroachment, requests for service or utility commitment letters; and
 - f. update on bond application no. 5.
12. Update on 11 lots partially within the City of Rosenberg boundaries.
13. Storm water management plan, training, and receive public comments.
14. Report regarding development in the District.
