

NOTICE OF MEETING

FORT BEND COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 155

The Board of Directors of Fort Bend County Municipal Utility District No. 155 will hold a regular meeting on **Monday, June 8, 2015, at 11:00 a.m.** at Bonbrook Plantation Recreational Center, 9210 Reading Road, Rosenberg, Texas, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following items:

 - b. approve Consumer Confidence Report and authorize operator to mail Consumer Confidence Report and file certificate of mailing with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality.
8. Hearing on termination of water and sewer service to delinquent customers and authorize termination of service.
9. Notification from City of Rosenberg regarding Groundwater Reduction Plan fee increases.
10. Garbage and recycling matters.
11. Update on detention/amenity lakes maintenance, including proposal for installation of irrigation system at Lake D and tree mulching.
12. Tax assessment and collections matters, including delinquent tax collections, installment agreements, payment of tax bills, and update on transition of tax collection services to the Fort Bend County Tax Assessor-Collector.
13. Authorize delinquent tax attorney to proceed with collection of delinquent taxes.
14. Engineering matters, including:
 - a. authorize design of facilities in the service area;
 - b. approve plans and specifications and authorize advertisement for bids for construction of projects in the service area;
 - c. review bids and award contract for construction;
 - d. approve pay estimates and change orders for construction of:
 - i. Bonbrook Plantation North, Section 14.
 - e. deeds, easements, consents to encroachment, requests for service or utility commitment letters; and
