

## NOTICE OF MEETING

### FORT BEND COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 155

The Board of Directors of Fort Bend County Municipal Utility District No. 155 will hold a regular meeting on **Monday, September 14, 2015, at 11:00 a.m.** at Bonbrook Plantation Recreational Center, 9210 Reading Road, Rosenberg, Texas, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following items:

1. Approve minutes.
2. Public comments.
3. Security services.
4. Renewal of Law Enforcement Service Contract with Fort Bend County.
5. Conduct public hearing regarding District's tax rate, adopt Order Levying Taxes, and authorize execution of Amendment to Information Form.
6. Financial and bookkeeping matters, including payment of the bills, review of investments and amend budget for fiscal year end April 30, 2016.
7. Operation of District water, sanitary sewer, and drainage facilities, billings and repairs and maintenance.
8. Hearing on termination of water and sewer service to delinquent customers and authorize termination of service.
9. Establishment of penalties for mis-use of District lakes and amend Rate Order, as appropriate, and letters of notice.
10. Garbage and recycling matters.
11. Update on detention/amenity lakes maintenance, including proposal for protection of irrigation system timer.
12. Tax assessment and collections matters, including delinquent tax collections, installment agreements, payment of tax bills, and update on transition of tax collection services to the Fort Bend County Tax Assessor-Collector.
13. Engineering matters, including:
  - a. authorize design of facilities in the service area;
  - b. approve plans and specifications and authorize advertisement for bids for construction of projects in the service area:
    - i. 144 acre tract, Bonbrook South;
  - c. review bids and award contract for construction;
  - d. approve pay estimates and change orders for construction of:
    - i. Bonbrook Plantation North, Section 14; and
    - ii. regional south master lift station phase II expansion and invoice for District's pro-rata share.
  - e. regional wastewater treatment plant improvements, including facilities to implement dry sludge hauling;
  - f. deeds, easements, consents to encroachment, requests for service or utility commitment letters; and

- 15. Update on lots partially within the City of Rosenberg boundaries.
- 16. Conflict of interest disclosure required under Chapter 176 of the Texas Local Government Code, including review of disclosure forms adopted by the Texas Ethics Commission and List of Local Government Officers for the District.
