The meeting will be held on Thursday, October 29, 2015, at 12:00 p.m.

The Board shall consider and discuss the following matters and take any action appropriate with respect to such matters:

1. Review and approval of the minutes of the September 14, 2015, Special Board of Directors meeting;
2. Tax Assessor-Collector Report, status of delinquent tax collections, authorize moving of accounts to uncollectible roll and authorize payment of invoices presented;
3. Report and legal action taken by the District's delinquent tax collections attorneys, including authorizing foreclosure proceedings, installment agreements and the filing of proofs of claim;
4. Conduct a public hearing regarding the adoption of the District's 2015 tax rates;
5. Levy of the District's 2015 debt service and maintenance tax rates, and the adoption of an Order in connection therewith;
6. Approval and execution of an Amendment to the Amended and Restated District Information Form;
7. Engineer's Report;
8. Annual review of Order Establishing Policy for Investment of District Funds and Appointing Investment Officer, and adoption of Resolution in connection therewith;
9. Bookkeeper's report, financial and investment reports, including:
 - a. Authorizing the payment of invoices presented; and
 - b. Report on discussion with IRS relative to alleged underpayment for tax year 2011;
10. Comments from the public;

11. Attorney's Report; and
12. Matters for possible placement on future agenda and establish next meeting date (December 2015).
