NOTICE OF SPECIAL PUBLIC MEETING

Notice is hereby given to all interested members of the public that the Board of Directors of the above captioned District will hold a special public meeting at 1300 Post Oak Boulevard, Suite 1400, Houston, Harris County, Texas, said address being an office and meeting place of the District.

The meeting will be held on Monday, February 8, 2016, at 12:00 Noon.

The Board shall consider and discuss the following matters and take any action appropriate with respect to such matters:

1. Review and approval of the minutes of the December 4, 2015, Special Board of Directors meeting;
2. Tax Assessor-Collector Report, status of delinquent tax collections, authorize moving of accounts to uncollectible roll and authorize payment of invoices presented;
3. Grant exemptions from taxation for 2016, and the adoption of a Resolution in connection therewith;
4. Adoption of Resolution Authorizing an Additional Penalty on Delinquent Personal Property Taxes and authorize delinquent tax attorney to collect delinquent personal property taxes beginning April 1, 2016, including the filing of lawsuits, as necessary;
5. Report and legal action taken by the District's delinquent tax collections attorneys, including authorizing foreclosure proceedings, installment agreements and the filing of proofs of claim;
6. Engineer's Report;
7. Bookkeeper's report, financial and investment reports, including:
 - a. Authorizing the payment of invoices presented; and
 - b. Report on discussion with IRS relative to alleged underpayment for tax year 2011;
8. Adoption of Resolution Adopting List of Qualified Brokers Authorized to Engage in Investment Transactions with District;
9. Authorize consultants to research unclaimed property and authorize bookkeeper to prepare Unclaimed Property Report as of March 1, 2016;

10. Review of annual survey of wage rate scales and consider adoption of Resolution Adopting Prevailing Wage Rate Scale for Construction Projects;
11. Discussion regarding implementation of disclosure requirements under HB 1295;
12. Renewal of District insurance policies;
13. Ratify approval of filing of Eminent Domain Report with the Texas Comptroller of Public Accounts prior to February 1, 2016, pursuant to Senate Bill 1812;
