


NOTICE OF MEETING

FORT BEND COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 148

The Board of Directors of Fort Bend County Municipal Utility District No. 148 will hold a regular meeting on Friday, September 2, 2016, at 8:30 a.m., at the Rosenberg Civic & Convention Center, 3825 Highway 36 South, Rosenberg, Texas, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following items:

1. Approve minutes.
2. Authorize auditor to conduct audit for fiscal year end September 30, 2016.
3. Financial and bookkeeping matters, including payment of bills and review of investments.
4. Adopt budget for fiscal year end September 30, 2017.
5. Tax assessment and collections matters, including delinquent tax collections, installment agreements, and payment of tax bills.
6. Conduct public hearing regarding District's tax rate, adopt Order Levying Taxes, and authorize execution of Amendment to Information Form.
7. Engineering matters, including:
 - a. design of construction projects in the District;
 - b. approve plans and specifications and authorize advertisement for bids for construction projects in the District;
 - c. review bids and award contract for construction of projects in the District;
 - d. approve pay estimate, change order, and final acceptance and direct engineer to notify insurance company of acceptance as appropriate, for construction projects in the District;
 - e. deeds and/or easements;
 - f. approve utility conveyances and security agreements; and
 - g. surplus funds application.
8. Adopt Resolution Authorizing Application to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality for Approval of Project and Bonds.
9. Report regarding development in the District.
10. Next meeting date and agenda items.
