 - iv. Detention Pond F;
 - d. approve pay estimates and change orders for construction of District projects;
 - i. Lift Station No. 2;
 - e. regional wastewater treatment plant improvements;

- f. regional lift station expansion; and
 - g. deeds, easements, consents to encroachment, requests for service or utility commitment letters.
