### FORT BEND COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 155



7. Operation of District water, sanitary sewer, and drainage facilities, billings, repairs and maintenance, and irrigation meter usage.
8. Hearing on termination of water and sewer service to delinquent customers and authorize termination of service.

10. Update on detention/amenity lakes maintenance and irrigation and landscaping maintenance.

12. Tax assessment and collections matters, including delinquent tax collections, installment agreements, payment of tax bills.

    - ii. Detention Pond E; and
    - iii. Detention Pond F;
  - e. regional wastewater treatment plant improvements;
  - f. regional lift station expansion; and
  - g. deeds, easements, consents to encroachment, requests for service or utility commitment letters.
