

# Interactive Web Map Help

## ***Map Tools***



Home – takes you to the original location and zoom level



Layers – turn layers on and off within the map



Legend – shows the symbology of the layers that are turned on in the map



My Location – zooms into your location



Measure – measure distance and area in a variety of units



Search – search Rosenberg addresses and FBCAD Parcel Numbers



Zoom – zoom in and zoom out (also accomplished with the scroll button on the mouse)



Draw – many different modes with lots of options, including adding text



Print – print the web map

## ***Tips & Tricks***

- Some maps may have layers turned off from the start for better clarity – always check the layer list if you would like to see additional layers that are not turned on
- Left click or tap the screen over a layer that is turned on to find additional details
  - Multiple layers with additional details may be present, to scroll through the layers there is a right arrow button to the top right
  - The layer that is selected will be highlighted in a light neon blue
- The drop down arrow next to the search box will let you choose between what layer you are searching in – the default is all
- My Location does not work well with non-mobile devices
- Latitude and Longitude are live in the bottom corner as well as within the draw tool
- The scale bar is bottom left
- Different maps will have different layers and different map tools
