



# Summary

The National Citizen Survey™ (The NCS™) is a collaborative effort between National Research Center, Inc. (NRC) and the International City/County Management Association (ICMA). The survey and its administration are standardized to assure high quality research methods and directly comparable results across The NCS communities. This report discusses differences in opinion of survey respondents by length of residency, annual household income, housing tenure, age and sex.

Responses in the following tables show only the proportion of respondents giving a certain answer; for example, the percent of respondents who rated the quality of life as “excellent” or “good,” or the percent of respondents who attended a public meeting more than once a month. ANOVA and chi-square tests of significance were applied to these comparisons of survey questions. A “p-value” of 0.05 or less indicates that there is less than a 5% probability that differences observed between subgroups are due to chance; or in other words, a greater than 95% probability that the differences observed are “real.” Where differences were statistically significant, they have been shaded grey.

The margin of error for this report is generally no greater than plus or minus seven percentage points around any given percent reported for the entire sample (198 completed surveys). For subgroups of responses, the margin of error increases because the sample size for the subgroup is smaller. For subgroups of approximately 100 respondents, the margin of error is plus or minus 10 percentage points.

Broadly, where differences in opinion were noted, a few general trends can be observed. Residents who had lived in Rosenberg for 6 to 20 years tended to give lower ratings to aspects of Community Characteristics than those who had lived in the City for more or less time, and those who rented their homes tended to give higher ratings to general aspects of Governance than homeowners. Residents age 55 or older generally participated in aspects of Community Engagement at higher rates than their counterparts. Male respondents tended to give higher ratings to aspects across all three pillars of community livability than female respondents, although there were a few exceptions to this.
