4. Tax assessment and collections matters, including delinquent tax collections, installment agreements, and payment of tax bills.
5. Approve Payment Services Agreement.
6. Operation of District facilities, billings, repairs, and maintenance.
7. Hearing on termination of water and sewer service to delinquent customers and authorize termination of service.
8. Engineering matters, including preparation of plans and specifications, approval of plans and specifications, advertisement for bids, bid review, contract award, Pay Estimates and Change Orders, acceptance of projects, and direct engineer to notify insurance company of new facility, if appropriate, for the following:
  - a. interim wastewater treatment plant site work;
  - b. Lift Station and Force Main to serve Stonecreek Estates;
  - c. water, sewer, drainage, and paving to serve Stonecreek Estates, Section 2;
  - d. sanitary sewer facilities to serve Stonecreek Estates recreation center; and
  - e. deeds, easements, consents to encroachment, requests for service or utility commitment letters.
9. Landscaping and park facilities, including preparation of plans and specifications, approval of plans and specifications, advertisement for bids, bid review, contract award, Pay Estimates and Change Orders, and acceptance of projects, if appropriate, for the following:
  - a. Phase One landscape improvements to serve Stonecreek Estates;
  - b. Phase One fencing improvements to serve Stonecreek Estates;
  - c. Stonecreek Estates Recreation Center;
  - d. Phase One Dry Creek landscape improvements; and
  - e. Mailbox pods, Section 1.
10. Approve Agreement with Environmental Allies.
