# TOP 5 CODE CONCERNS FOR MARCH

*During the month of March, 175 new Code Enforcement cases were opened. The top 5 violations were:*

- **108 Property Maintenance Issues:** Homes must not be in disrepair; broken windows or down fences must be repaired within 10 days; sewer issues must be addressed within 3 days.
- **42 Junk Vehicle Violations:** Vehicles must have a current plate or registration, not be dismantled or wrecked & be operable.
- **16 Sign Violations:** No off-premise signs allowed.
- **4 Building Violations:** Permits are required for most projects.
- **1 Stormwater Violation:** Keep common pollutants such as pesticides, pet waste, grass clippings & automotive fluids off the ground & out of the storm water system.
