BIOTICS RESEARCH CORPORATION BREAKS GROUND ON \$9 MILLION NEW FACILITY IN ROSENBERG BUSINESS PARK

Biotics Research Corporation, a nutritional supplement company, recently broke ground on their new \$9 million facility in the Rosenberg Business Park. Biotics Research has been in Rosenberg for 25 years and will retain their existing manufacturing building.

The 87,569 square foot new facility will add to their existing footprint and serve as their corporate headquarters, research facility, warehouse, and distribution site. This expansion will retain 160 jobs and add 25 new jobs over five years making Biotics one of the largest employers in the City.

“Biotics Research is a valued member of the Rosenberg business community. We are thrilled to work with them and congratulate them on their expansion to the 184-acre deed restricted Rosenberg Business Park,” said Rosenberg Mayor Kevin Raines. “The Business Park was developed not only to attract new businesses to our city, but to retain and create opportunities for existing businesses such as Biotics Research.”
