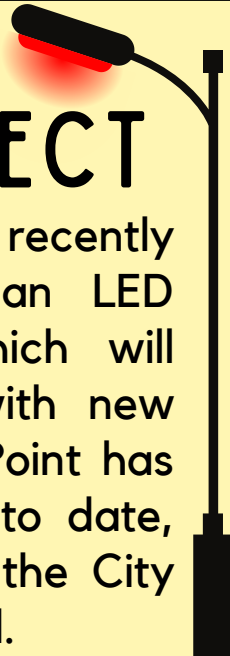


CODE ENFORCEMENT REPORT

In the month of January, there were 154 new Code Enforcement cases opened. Of the new cases, 69 or 45% were property maintenance issues. 11 of the new cases were from citizen complaints and the other 143 or 93% were proactive cases which means they were initiated by the City. Also during the month of January, 135 code cases were resolved and there are 138 outstanding code cases which staff are still actively pursuing. **Need to report a concern? LED STREET LIGHT CONVERSION PROJECT

CenterPoint Energy and the City recently entered into an agreement for an LED Streetlight Conversion Project which will replace the existing streetlights with new energy efficient LED bulbs. CenterPoint has replaced approximately 742 lights to date, and work will continue throughout the City until all the lights have been replaced.
