

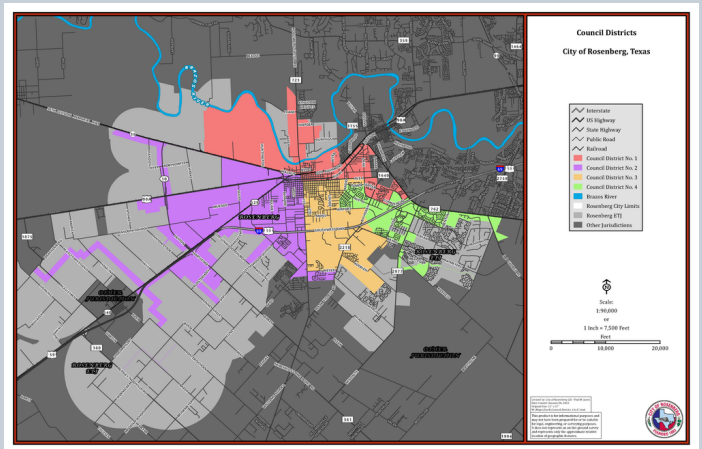


## May 7, 2022 General Election

The next General Election will be on Saturday, May 7, 2022, from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. at Rosenberg City Hall Council Chambers, located at 2110 4th Street, Rosenberg, Texas 77471. Positions on the ballot for the general election are: Mayor, Councilor At Large-Position 1, Councilor At Large-Position 2, and Councilors, District 1, 2, 3 and 4. These positions will serve a two-year term.

**Reminder: at the January 4, 2022 City Council Meeting, new City Council district boundary lines were formally adopted.**

# REMINDER!

## SOLID WASTE & RECYCLING CART RULES

Per City Ordinance, residents may not place carts in the street right-of-way prior to noon the day before collection. Carts must be placed out no later than 7 a.m. the day of collection. Emptied carts must then be removed from the street no later than 8 a.m. the morning following collection. Failure to abide by these rules could result in a citation.

Please allow 3 feet between carts and other objects such as cars, fences or mailboxes to help facilitate automated pick up.

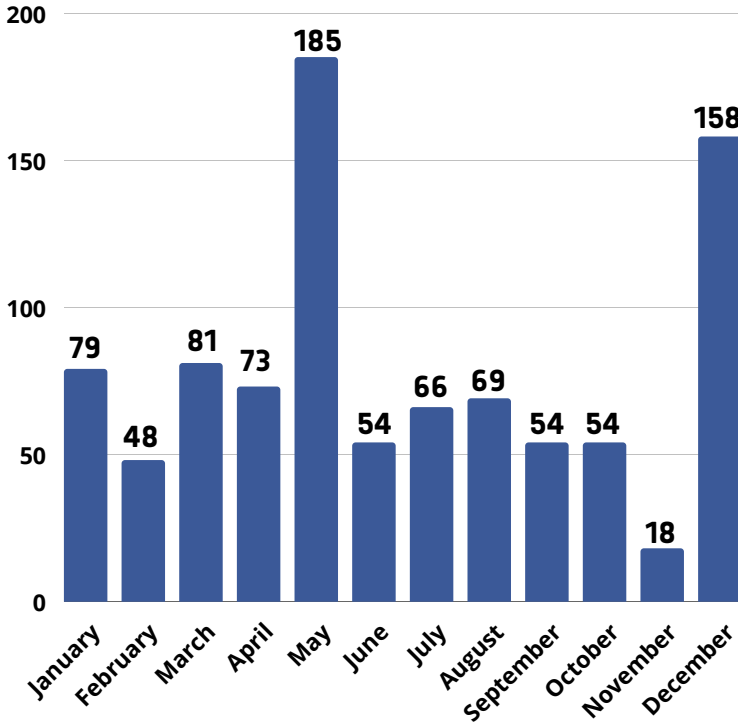

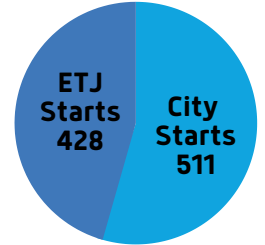
## A look back on housing starts for 2021.
