You can shred more than eight (8) boxes in total, but you must re-enter the line.**

Highway 90A Revitalization Project Update

Progress is well underway with the US 90A (Avenue H) Revitalization Project. Recent efforts have been focused on establishing a strategic plan for the approval of City Council and the Rosenberg Development Corporation. The plan will define what success looks like in promoting the redevelopment and revitalization of properties situated along the corridor from the Richmond city limits to the Triple Fork.

Visual appearance is a major component of the revitalization project. Elements such as sidewalks, landscaping, signage, overhead powerlines, and more are under consideration for visual updates. The City Code of Ordinances is being reviewed as staff makes progress with conducting code audits of the corridor.

City staff was authorized to submit a Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) Transportation Alternative Grant application at the January 17, 2023, City Council Meeting. The grant is focused on the planning efforts to create a master plan that will enhance the safety, access, mobility, and appearance of the corridor. Utilizing the Livable Centers Study, conducted in 2015 with the assistance of the Houston-Galveston Area Council (H-GAC), Rosenberg was provided a solid foundation for planning and development of the US 90A transportation corridor.

Reminder: Street Sweeping on Mondays

Working together we can keep our streets, drainage system, and water supply clean! Street sweeping is intended to prolong the life of the City's street and drainage infrastructure by removing dirt, sand, and other contaminants from the roadway before they enter the City's storm drainage system.

For the sweeper to complete an effective and efficient route, residents are asked to remove vehicles parked along the street on Mondays. Residents with Monday solid waste services are encouraged to place their poly carts in their driveways or upon the curb so the sweeper may clean the whole street.
