

# 2023 ELECTION

The City of Rosenberg will hold a **Bond Election and Special Election for Charter Amendments** on Tuesday, November 7, 2023.

Early Voting: Oct. 23 - Nov. 3 | Election Day: Nov. 7

The **Bond Election** will be to submit propositions to voters to determine whether the City Council shall be authorized to issue bonds for the construction of two facilities: an Emergency Services Complex and Public Services Complex.

The **Special Election** will be for the purpose of submitting to the qualified voters, for adoption or rejection, of proposed amendments to the existing home-rule charter of the City of Rosenberg. There are 51 proposed amendments to the Rosenberg City Charter to be voted on.

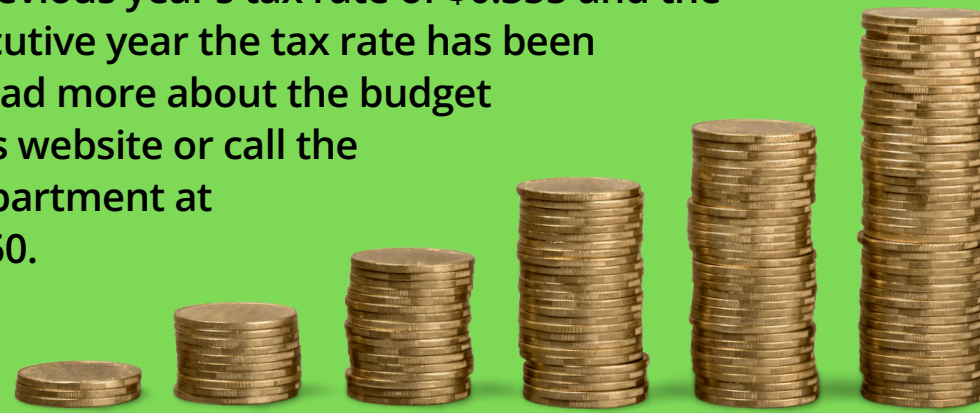

# FISCAL YEAR 23-24 BUDGET & TAX RATE



Rosenberg City Council has adopted a new budget and tax rate for the 2023-2024 fiscal year! The total budget was in the amount of \$101,728,442. The new property tax rate is \$0.342364 per \$100 valuation; a 3.56% decrease from the previous year's tax rate of \$0.355 and the 11th consecutive year the tax rate has been lowered. # ROSENBERG DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION

The Rosenberg Development Corporation (RDC) was created by election in 1995 as a Type-B economic development corporation. The RDC is funded by a one-half cent sales tax, and state law authorizes the RDC to engage in projects related to primary job creation and quality of life. Comprised of a board of seven directors appointed by Rosenberg City Council, the RDC has engaged in a variety of projects over the years.

The proposed RDC Projects for Fiscal Year 2024 are:

- **US 90A Corridor Revitalization** – The RDC is committed to the revitalization efforts of the Avenue H/US 90A Revitalization Project, with a contribution of \$1 million in FY24.
- **Parks Improvements and Texas Master Naturalists Agreement** – These funds, totaling \$100,000, will be utilized for a variety of projects in Rosenberg’s great parks system, with a portion of those funds going towards the Texas Master Naturalist annual agreement with the city.
- **Travis Park Splashpad Improvements** – A water recirculation system for the Travis Park Splashpad is on the list of proposed projects for a total of \$350,000.
- **Wayfinding Signs** – Additional funding of \$100,000 is going to be contributed to the city’s Wayfinding Sign Project, which is currently in progress.
- **I-69 Connector at Brazos Town Center I & II** – As a public safety improvement project, the RDC is contributing an additional \$200,000 towards a roadway connecting both sections of Brazos Town Center under the I-69 overpass.
