

Rosenberg Fire Department's New Engine 3 Placed Into Service



The City of Rosenberg Fire Department's new Fire Engine 3 was officially placed into service on Monday, February 19, 2024. The new 2024 Spartan Fire Engine, capable of holding 750 gallons of water and pumping 1,500 gallons per minute, is equipped with an array of fire gear and life support equipment.

The new apparatus replaces a 2013 Pierce Impel Pumper truck which will be placed in reserve status for the next several years.

Engine 3 is also a vital part of the City's strategic plan Goals for a Safe and Attractive Community, providing high-quality professional public safety and emergency services to meet the community's current and future needs.

"This is an exciting time for Rosenberg Fire," said Assistant Fire Chief Jack Helton who oversaw the acquisition of the new engine and oversees the Operations Division of the Fire Department. "By adding state-of-the-art apparatus such as Engine 3 and Tower 4 in 2023, we are working to constantly improve our services and enhance the department's capabilities in responding to various emergencies, EMS calls, fires and specialized rescue incidents."

Engine 3 was purchased through Metro Fire Apparatus Specialist, Inc. and will be stationed at Fire Station #3 at 6226 August Green Drive, Rosenberg, TX 77469.

What does that have to do with Code Compliance you may ask? For the first time in the Department's History - all the Code Compliance Officers are female!

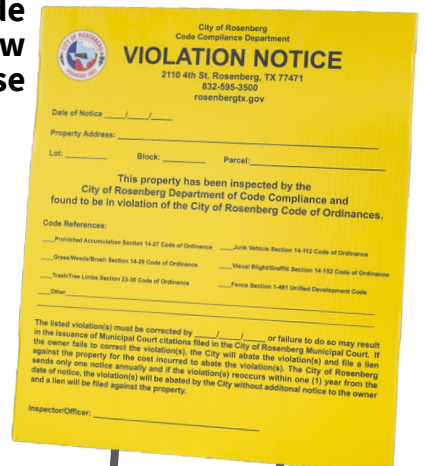

Village Crossing Development Update

One of Rosenberg’s latest commercial developments, Village Crossing, is a mixed-use development set to bring new businesses to Rosenberg. Located between Reading Road and FM 2218, the 108-acre development offers pad sites for a variety of commercial uses. In December of 2017, a performance agreement between Village Crossing, LLC, and the Rosenberg Development Corporation (RDC) was approved. Per the agreement, the RDC contributed funds for the public infrastructure including the extension of Airport Avenue to the I-69 frontage road.

As the infrastructure improvements were completed, Village Crossing welcomed in Cavender’s Boot City, a popular western wear store located at 25850 Southwest Freeway. The development expects to see a variety of additional retailers, medical services, and restaurants. Vida Mariscos restaurant recently broke ground on their newest location next to Cavender’s, and several other businesses, including a medical facility are in the works.

Village Crossing is currently preparing for growth by creating an on-site storm water detention pond and building up pad sites for new buildings. Stay tuned for updates!
