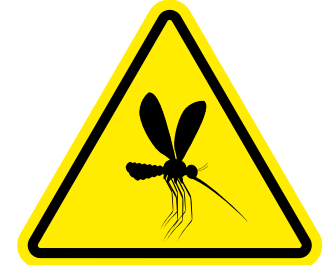

MOSQUITO SEASON



During peak mosquito season, the City of Rosenberg sprays within the City limits twice a week in an attempt to help control the mosquito population. But, it takes everyone doing their part to keep the pests (and potential diseases they can carry) under control. Residents should not rely solely on the City's mosquito spraying for protection from deadly diseases carried by certain mosquitoes. Mosquito spraying does not include alleys or private properties such as apartment complexes and mobile home parks.
