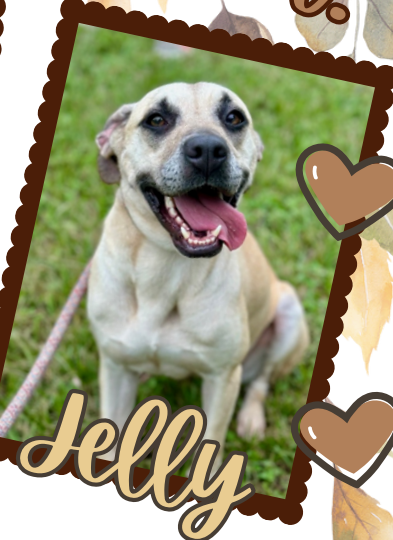


Fall in Love with a Shelter Pet!

REMINDER! Solid waste collection rates increased Oct. 1st

The new residential regular rate for trash collection and disposal is now \$18.64 per month - an increase of \$.45 over the old rate of \$18.19 per month. The new residential rate for those over 65 years of age increased \$.39 to \$16.08 per month from \$15.69 per month. Additional polycarts, commercial services and roll-offs also increased by 2.46%.

Code Reminders: Tall Grass and Accumulation

As we welcome the crisp fall breeze, let's keep Rosenberg beautiful by trimming that tall grass and clearing away any clutter! Remember, it's city ordinance! All property needs to be free of weeds, grass, brush or other vegetation that is greater than twelve (12) inches in height. All accumulated refuse, including newspapers, abandoned vehicles, refrigerators, stoves, furniture, tires, and cans, on premises in a neighborhood, is against city ordinance unless the refuse or object is completely enclosed in a building, or is not visible from a public street. SITE READINESS PROGRAM

The Rosenberg Development Corporation (RDC) is establishing a Site Readiness program during Fiscal Year 2025. The program’s goal is to prepare suitable sites and develop necessary infrastructure connections for future commercial development. The RDC has budgeted \$100,000 to kickstart the program.

Rosenberg encompasses 106 square miles of land, much of which is undeveloped. Situated in the path of growth, the City is making the conscience effort to be proactive in setting the community up for success. Much of the acreage in Rosenberg and its exterritorial jurisdiction (ETJ) is considered to be “greenfield,” or undeveloped land currently being used for agriculture. Because these sites are vacant of any development, the sites must be prepared for use, often referred to as site readiness.

One of the biggest challenges landowners and developers face is the availability of utilities to support the site. This includes electricity, water and wastewater. Oftentimes, prospective commercial developments want access to city water and wastewater, and the city must identify the best way to serve the site. Alongside those efforts, the city works closely with CenterPoint Energy to ensure electricity and gas needs can be met for larger projects.

The RDC’s Site Readiness Program was established as a goal in the adopted Economic Development Strategic Plan. When site selectors and their potential customers are evaluating prospective locations, it is imperative that they have a clear understanding of which sites feature fully serviced utility infrastructure or service that can be constructed quickly.

Staff will continue to establish the Site Readiness program and will serve as a resource for developers and site selectors who continue to show interest in Rosenberg.
