You have three opportunities to make things right before the annual Case Resolution Campaign (formerly known as the Warrant Round-Up). This year's Case Resolution Campaign will be held March 16-22 and arrests for outstanding warrants will be made. To help you resolve your warrants before this campaign, the Safe Harbor Warrant Days provide a unique opportunity to address your warrants without the fear of arrest.

**DRIVE-THRU SHREDDING EVENT**  
 Saturday, March 1 • 9 a.m. to Noon • City Hall

To participate in the event, you must be a Rosenberg resident and show proof of residency onsite (utility bill/driver's license). This is a drive-thru event. Residents must stay in their vehicle and onsite personnel will remove documents from the vehicle for secure onsite shredding and recycling. Only eight (8) boxes will be shredded per vehicle at one time. You can shred more than eight boxes in total but you must re-enter the line. Items must be placed in the trunk or rear of the vehicle and clearly labeled for shredding. While these clippings are natural, they still pollute our waterways. As yard waste decomposes, it requires oxygen — oxygen that fish and other aquatic life need to survive. Grass clippings left on the lawn return valuable nutrients to the soil. It's a win for your yard and the environment!

**NEW COUNCIL CORNER** *a new section where we highlight key decisions and updates from City Council meetings over the past month!*

- The Rosenberg Development Corporation presented their annual report to City Council. See the report at [RosenbergTX.Gov/RDC](http://RosenbergTX.Gov/RDC)
- City Council awarded a contract to DN Tanks, LLC, in the amount of \$4,949,800 for an additional ground water storage tank to be constructed at Water Plant No. 8. This is required to store additional potable water to meet increased water demands, remain in compliance with Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) regulations, and placed into operation in advance of the sixty percent (60%) groundwater reduction mandate from the Fort Bend Subsidence District which is effective October 1, 2027.
- City Council awarded a contract to T Construction, LLC, in the amount of \$515,397.00 for improvements to the culvert crossing under the railroad tracks located near the intersection of Old Richmond Road and 8th Street to alleviate drainage issues in the area surrounding Theater Ditch North. This is one phase of a multiphase project to improve dry creek drainage utilizing mitigation grant funding through the General Land Office.
- Acceptance of an Award Letter through the Texas Division of Emergency Management (TDEM) for the Federal Emergency Management Agency's (FEMA), Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP) for backup power supplies for critical facilities. The Project includes the replacement of generators at City Hall, the Police Station and Fire Station No. 2 to mitigate the facilities from power loss due to natural hazards. This grant reimburses the City for ninety percent (90%) or \$552,958.20 of the \$614,398.00 Project cost, with the City responsible for the remaining \$61,439.80 or ten percent (10%).
- City Council was presented an update on the design of the Emergency Services Complex which will include Fire Station No. 4, Fire Administration and an Emergency Operations Center; and the Public Services Complex to house Public Works, Utilities, Fleet Maintenance, Building Maintenance, City Engineer, Capital Projects, Parks and other City departments, which were approved by the City of Rosenberg voters through a bond election held in November 2023.
- At the City Council Workshop Meeting, Council discussed and expressed consensus for the Rosenberg Police Department Motorcycle Unit Policy, the FY2025 Street Improvement list, the FY2025 Sidewalk Removal and Replacement list, a change to the UDC to increase side yard setbacks for 70-foot lots from 5-foot setbacks to 10-foot setbacks and a transfer of a mobile command center trailer from Fort Bend County to the City. These items will be brought back to City Council for formal action at future meetings.
