Council Corner: Highlights of key actions and decisions from City Council meetings held the previous month.

- City Council approved Resolution R-3827 adopting a Police Motorcycle Unit Policy
- Approved the FY2025 Street Overlay Project List. Streets include: Damon, Rude, 6th, Jones, Laurel, Tobola, Oak, Elm, Lindsey, Ave D, J and L, Travis and Houston.
- Approved the FY2025 Sidewalk Repair and Replacement. See the list of sidewalks on the website Agenda Center for the Feb. 4, 2025 meeting.
- Approved a funding agreement in the amount of \$50,000 with the Texas Master Naturalists for improvements to Seabourne Creek Nature Park.
- Approved Resolution R-3804, an interlocal agreement, between the City and Fort Bend County for fire protection services in the unincorporated areas of the County.
- Approved Ordinance No. 2025-06 adopting official forms for recall, initiative and referendum petitions.
- Approved Resolution R-3831, an agreement between the City and Kaluza, Inc. for professional engineering services for the 4th Street extension project.
- Approved Resolution R-3832, an agreement between the City and CivilCorp, LLC for professional engineering services for the new entrance to the Seabourne Creek Sports Complex from FM 2218.
- Approved Resolution No. R-3836, to submit a request to increase the amount of Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funding for the North Rosenberg Water Distribution Improvements Project – Phase VIII from \$666,675.00 to \$1,646,081.26.
- Approved Resolution No. R-3830, appointing the City Manager as the Chief Executive Officer and Authorized Representative for the FEMA Hazard Mitigation Assistance (HMA) Grant Project and committing the City of Rosenberg to provide matching funds to secure and complete the FEMA Hazard Mitigation Grant.

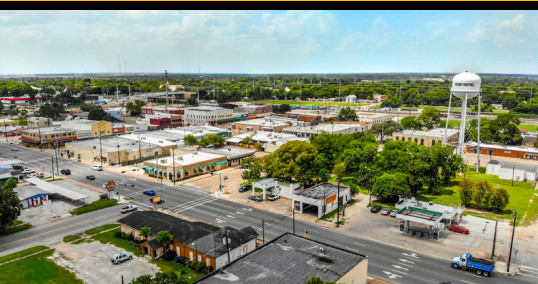
