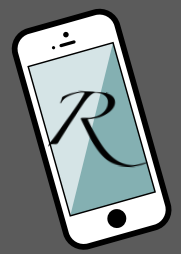

COUNCIL CORNER: Council happenings for the month of March.

- Speed Limit Changes:**
 - The speed limit on the US-59/IH-69 main lanes will be reduced to 65 mph from south of Reading Road to south of Kroesche Road, extending to the centerline of Spur 529. The frontage roads' speed limit will be set at 50 mph from the centerline of Leon Road to Spur 529.
- Resolutions & Ordinances:**
 - R-3839: Approved an interlocal agreement with MyGovernmentOnline (MGO) Software for permitting, licensing, planning, code compliance and public works.
 - R-3835: Awarded Bid No. 2025-31B for the construction of Water Plant No. 9.
 - Ordinance 2025-09: Updated RV regulations, allowing electrical connections outside RV parks but prohibiting water and sewer connections.
 - R-3834: Approved a bid to recoat the Elevated Water Storage Tank in Historic Downtown Rosenberg.
- Police Department:**
 - Approved the purchase of two 2025 Chevrolet Tahoe's for \$112,900.
 - R-3845: Approved a re-accreditation between the City and the Texas Police Chiefs Association Foundation.
 - R-3846: Approved the placement of Automated License Plate Recognition cameras in the TxDOT right-of-way.
- City Manager Update:**
 - Terminated City Manager John Maresh's contract, effective March 18, 2025.
 - Appointed Joyce Vasut as Interim City Manager, effective the same date.

Becerra's Grocery Building - 500 2nd St.

Have you seen the restoration of the old Becerra's Grocery at 500 2nd Street? Owners Thomas Becerra and Roberta "Roie" Griego applied for the Rosenberg Development Corporation's Business Improvement Grant program to stretch their restoration budget and breathe new life into this northside staple that had been closed for years.

The building, which is currently vacant, was originally opened in the 1930s as a neighborhood grocery store serving north Rosenberg and was owned and operated by the Becerra family until 2010 when the applicant's father could no longer operate the business due to health concerns. Thomas Becerra and his partner Roie Griego are working to revive this family legacy and resume serving the residents of north Rosenberg with convenient access to fresh produce and pantry goods. Now that the building has been renovated, Becerra and Griego are seeking a tenant grocer to occupy the refreshed space.

The RDC was pleased to provide a reimbursement grant to aid in revitalizing this historic commercial property with exterior improvements, such as paint, doors and windows, and a new walkway awning with lighting and electrical components.
