REMINDER: STREET SWEEPING ON MONDAYS & TUESDAYS

Working together, we can keep our streets, drainage system, and water supply clean. Street sweeping helps prolong the life of the City's streets and drainage infrastructure by removing dirt, sand, and other contaminants from roadways before they enter the storm drainage system. Residents are encouraged to place their garbage carts in driveways and remove vehicles from the street so sweepers can clean the entire roadway. ROSENBERG DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION

The Rosenberg Development Corporation (RDC) project approval process ensures careful, transparent use of funds for economic growth in Rosenberg.

Project List Recommendation: City staff reviews CIP plans and growth areas to prioritize Type B-eligible projects, then prepares a list. The RDC Finance Committee reviews and recommends changes, followed by final tweaks and recommendation from the full RDC Board.

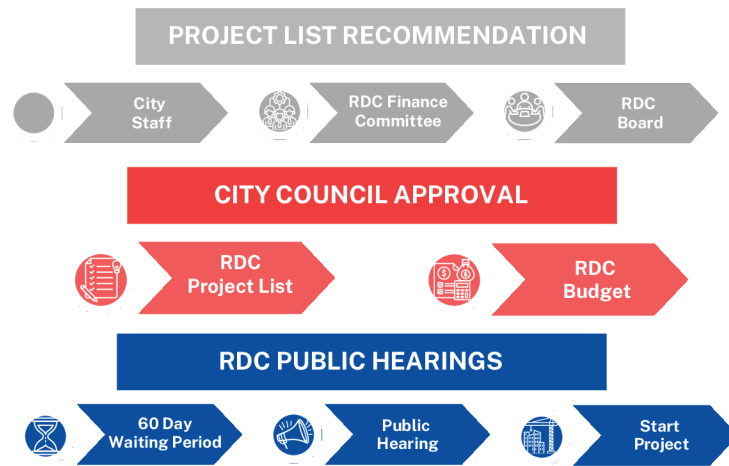
City Council Approval: Council reviews the project list and RDC budget, modifies as needed, and has full approval authority of both. Public hearings are required throughout this process and it runs concurrently with the budget process for the City's general fund.

RDC Public Hearings: In addition to the public hearings for the City's budget, additional hearings are required for a development corporation. The RDC publishes a notice with project details and costs, starting a 60-day wait. A public hearing occurs within this period and after the 60 days, approved projects begin following City purchasing rules.

This multi-step process prioritizes community input and accountability.
