

Election Season is Here!

Local elections are important and play a vital role in shaping city services, infrastructure and the overall direction of Rosenberg's future. Did you know that voter participation in the May 4, 2024 General Election was extremely low? Only 1,720 of the City's 21,783 registered voters cast a ballot. That's just 8% of eligible voters. This means a small percentage of residents ultimately shaped outcomes that affect the entire community.

In the upcoming election, citizens will consider the creation of a Crime Control and Prevention District, proposed City Charter Amendments and the selection of a new City Council. The mayoral race, previously featured in last month's Insider, includes candidates Susan Kroll Euton and William Benton. Below are all the candidates, including those for Mayor, At-Large Positions 1 and 2 and Districts 1 through 4, listed in ballot order.

Did you know property owners are responsible for mowing the grass all the way to the edge of the street and in the alley? Grass and weeds may not exceed 12 inches in height.

Sec. 14-29. - Limitation of height of grass and weeds.

BULKY TRASH IS COLLECTED WEEKLY

- Bulky trash is collected on your first service date of each week (Monday or Tuesday)
- Construction materials will not be serviced.
- Bulky pickup is heavier or larger items that do not fit in the trash container.
- Overflow or extra trash is not considered "bulky item" trash and will not be picked up.
