The Rosenberg Civic Center is a 16,000 square feet space for corporate and social functions. The space is available for rent and includes a 5,900 square feet main hall (which can be split into two smaller rooms with a wall partition), three breakout rooms, a state-of-the-art multimedia room, a boardroom, and a catering kitchen.

Is Your Address Visible?

Properly indicating the address of your home is imperative in emergency situations. A clearly visible address allows emergency personnel, such as Fire Fighters and Police Officers, to locate your property quickly and safely.

The City of Rosenberg building code requires:

- Buildings shall have approved address numbers, building numbers or approved building identification placed in a position that is plainly legible and visible from the street or road fronting the property.
- These numbers shall contrast with their background.
- Address numbers shall be Arabic numbers or alphabetical letters.
- Numbers shall be a minimum of 4 inches (102 mm) high with a minimum stroke width of 1/2 inch (12.7 mm).
- Where access is by means of a private road and the building address cannot be viewed from the public way, a monument, pole or other sign or means shall be used to identify the structure.



Fight The Bite

During rainy season, the City of Rosenberg sprays twice a week within the city limits in an attempt to help control the mosquito population, but it takes everyone doing their part to keep the pests (and potential diseases they can carry) under control. Take responsibility for your own health by following these suggestions from the Texas Department of State Health Services to protect yourself and your family from mosquitoes:

- DRAIN any standing water in your yard – Mosquitoes love to breed in stagnant water. This includes pools, broken flower pots or other open containers, clogged rain gutters, and bird baths.
- DRESS in long sleeves and pants if you are outside and mosquitoes are active. For extra protection, spray clothing and exposed body areas with repellent.
- DUSK/DAWN is when mosquitoes are most active. Try your best to stay indoors! If going out, use repellent.
- DEET (n,n-diethyl-m-toluamide) is an ingredient to look for in your insect repellent. Other acceptable repellents contain Oil of Lemon Eucalyptus or Picaridin. Also consider using appropriate sprays for your yard. Always wear repellent when you are outside and follow label instructions; do not allow children to apply their own repellent.

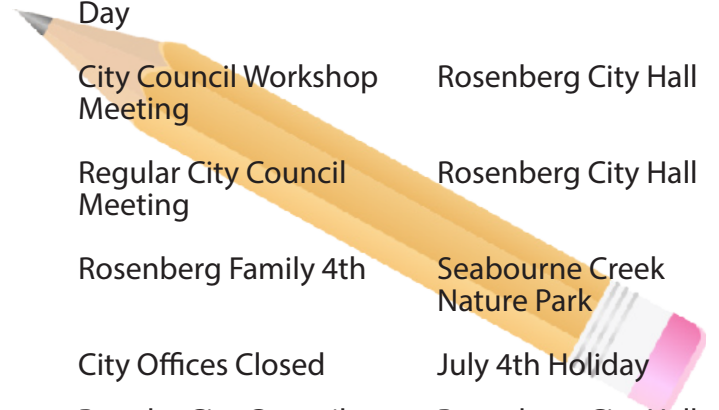

Building and Electrical Code Adoptions

City Council Members approved ordinance No. 2019-23 adopting the 2018 International Building, Fire, Residential, Plumbing, Mechanical, Fuel Gas, Swimming Pool and Spa and Existing Building Codes, and the 2017 National Electrical Code at the May 14 Council Meeting.

The implementation process of the new codes will include a 45-day grace period for ongoing projects before new submittals will be required to be in compliance. There will also be a six (6) month review process to observe the codes implementation and determine if any amendments or adjustments are needed.
