City of Rosenberg Travis Park Splash Pad

Regular Operating Schedule

April 1 – September 30

Open daily from 11:00 am – 8:00 pm

October 1 – October 31

Weekends only from 11:00 am – 6:00 pm

Closed for one day a week for maintenance at the discretion of the Parks Director.

Travis Park Splash Pad Rules

No lifeguard on Duty. All children must have adult supervision at all times.

Please use the splash pad at your own risk.

In case of thunderstorm, lightning or severe weather, vacate the splash pad immediately.

All tobacco products, including electronic cigarettes, are prohibited.

Do not use splash pad if you feel ill, have a contagious disease, or have diarrhea

No running, roughhousing or profane language permitted on or around splash pad.

Infants and toddlers must wear a swim diaper. Do not change diapers within 6-feet of the splash area.

Food, glass and drinks are not permitted within the splash pad area.

No skateboards, bicycles, scooters or similar recreation equipment allowed.

Strollers and wheelchairs are permitted.

Proper attire must be worn at all times. All apparel must be clean prior to entering the play area. Water shoes are recommended.

For your safety, do not obstruct water features, or climb or swing on the splash pad equipment.

Non-service animals are prohibited.

Toys, water balloons, beach balls, pool noodles, buckets, and water guns are not permitted.

No bathing, soap, detergent, or shampoo allowed.

Individuals engaged in unsafe, disruptive behavior, or violating any of the above rules will be asked to leave the splash pad area.
